### WE OFFER:

- 15 hours of English lessons each week for individual students and groups of students aged 16 years plus
- Fun interactive lessons using books, tapes, videos and games
- Elementary to advanced levels
- Maximum of 18 students per class
- Accommodation with host families
- Afternoon social activities
- Weekly full day excursions to other cities in the UK.

You will improve your skills in grammar, speaking, listening, reading and writing and increase your vocabulary.

Summer English is your opportunity to have fun, experience British culture, make friends with people of different nationalities and improve your English.

### STOKE PARK

Summer English is taught at Guildford College's Stoke Park Campus, which is set in parkland near Guildford town centre, in the south east of the UK.

Stoke Park has a modern Learning Resource Centre with a dedicated EFL Zone and over 100 computers offering unlimited free internet access.

It also has a Food Zone serving hot and cold food, which forms a central meeting point for all students.

### GUILDFORD

The centre of Guildford is only a short 10 minute walk away from Stoke Park. It is an excellent location for international students and is the safest county in the UK. Guildford has great shopping, eating and many traditional cultural places of interest including a castle and cathedral. It also has a nine screen cinema and two theatres.

Stoke Park is very close to the Spectrum Leisure Centre, which offers ten pin bowling, ice skating and gym facilities and also to the Guildford Lido, a outdoor heated swimming pool. Stoke Park itself is just round the corner and offers the opportunity to play crazy golf, rounders, a game of football and more.

After all this, London is only 40 minutes away by train and Gatwick and Heathrow International airports are a short 35 minute drive away.
